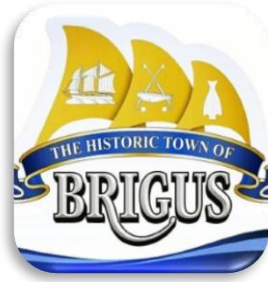

Town Of Brigus Sports & Recreation Summer Program Registration 2019

Dear Parents/Guardians,

The Town of Brigus is pleased to be offering a summer recreation program again for this year, and we look forward to seeing your child take part in this opportunity.

This parent / guardian handbook has been put together to provide you with key information regarding your child's upcoming experience in The Town Of Brigus Sports & Recreation Summer Program We are very pleased that you have chosen our program, and want to assure you that our goal is to provide your child with a fun, safe and well-rounded program experience.

Fees/Ages

There will be an \$85.00 dollar fee for each child participating in the summer program. The program will be available for children ages 5-12 and will run from July 2nd to August 16th 2019. **Your child must be 5 years of age, as of June 30th** to be eligible for the program.

Holidays

There will be no program on Monday July 1st and July 15th due to Provincial Holidays.

There will also be no program from Thursday August 8th - Tuesday August 13th, due to the running of the annual Brigus Blueberry Festival, Children will return Wednesday August 14th.

Safety

It is extremely important that all program participants understand the rules established for the program. No child will be allowed to wander off unsupervised or leave the grounds without permission and supervision. Continued disrespect for the rules and/or the counsellors will result in suitable action to guarantee the safety of all participants. Parent / guardians are asked to reinforce the importance of safety and respect to their children during the course of the program.

3-Strike Rule

During the program, inappropriate and / or disrespectful behaviour will be managed using the 3-Strike Rule. For each incidence of inappropriate behaviour, undesirable behaviour, intentional physical harm or bullying during the program, the child will be issued a verbal "warning/strike".

When the child receives strike one, the head counsellor will document the name and the parent/guardian will be notified at the end of the day upon pick-up

Once the child has received strike two, the child's parent / guardian will be contacted, and the child will be sent home for the remainder of the day.

When the child reaches strike three, the child will be removed for a minimum of 1 full day. This could also potentially result in termination. This rule will be implemented over the course of the summer. Intentional physical harm to other children will **NOT** be tolerated.

Pick Up – Drop Off

Children should **NOT BE DROPPED OFF BEFORE 9:00 AM OR 1:00 PM** and they should be picked **UP NO LATER THAN 11:50 AM or 3:50 PM** depending on which week it is on the schedule.

Groups will alternate drop off and pick up times weekly.

Outings:

On days that field trips are scheduled drop off and pick up times can alternate. Children will be split into groups, to ensure that only children of the appropriate age will be participating in activities together. Also, we could use the help of some parents for the field trips. Seating priority will be given to children and camp counselors. If there is not enough space on the bus for a parent, we would appreciate if you could meet us at the site. A chaperone will be required during field trips for any child with special needs.

While on outings we ask that children try to just avail of what the town is providing. Not all children are able to bring along money to buy extras and we wouldn't want anyone to feel left out.

Child Release

Electronic devices

Electronic devices will not be permitted to be used during the program.

Checklist

Here is a list of items / reminders that will ensure that your child is prepared for the day's activities:

- Children should label all articles worn or brought with child's name.
- Older clothing should be worn to avoid the frustration of good clothing being ruined. Also a change of clothes and towel should be packed daily in case of water play.
- A hat and sunscreen should be worn everyday before arriving as well as packed in their bag to reapply during the day.
- Children should be dressed according to the weather. Running shoes/ Closed toed Sandals are recommended.

NO FLIP FLOPS

- Children should have extra water / refillable water bottle to prevent dehydration throughout the day.
- Snacks must be brought from home each day.

Transportation

Getting to and from the program each day is the responsibility of the parent / guardian of the camp participant. During the program, when necessary, school buses will be rented in order to transport participants to various facilities. Drop off and pick up location will be at the Brigus Playground. If it is raining the location will be changed to the Brigus Recreation Centre.

Participation

Each day that your child attends camp, he or she is expected to participate in all camp activities. Your child should not be dropped off with the intention of not participating in camp activities. Your child should want to come and be active and enjoy the activities offered.

Lost and Found

Items may be forgotten or misplaced. Any items found during the camp will be placed at the town hall and will be kept until the end of the summer program. After this time, all items will be donated to a charitable organization. In order to avoid confusion and loss of items, we strongly suggest that all clothing and supplies, which is brought to the program, be labelled with the child's name.
